In accordance with State Bylaw Article 2, §222, St. Francis High School has an open enrollment policy. St. Francis High School does not discriminate against any applicant because of race, religion, or national origin in conformity with Christian charity and the Civil Rights Act of 1964. It admits students of any race, color, racial or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs and activities generally accorded or made available for all students at the school. The School does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, racial or ethnic origin in the admission of its educational policies, scholarships and loan programs, or other school programs. St. Francis High School seeks to admit students who wish to excel academically, socially, and spiritually.

It is in keeping with the school's high academic and moral standards that we ask students to complete the requirements upon seeking admission to the school. The specialized nature of the academic program (college preparatory) at St. Francis makes it impossible to accept every candidate for admission. Experience has shown the best criteria for the selection of students to consist in a COMBINATION of the following listed below.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCEPTANCE CONSIDERATION: transcripts from the applicant's present and/or previous school; standardized mental ability and/or achievement test scores (as taken in student's current school); a recommendation (evaluation) from a teacher, counselor and/or administrator who knows the applicant well (**the required form for this is sent by St. Francis directly to the applicant's school**); a completed Pastor Recommendation form; and a student/family interview which will be scheduled by appointment and for which applicants will be notified.

ALL APPLICANTS: UNLESS AND UNTIL ALL REQUESTED INFORMATION HAS BEEN SUPPLIED AND AN INTERVIEW HAS BEEN CONCLUDED, NO DECISION WILL BE MADE ON THE APPLICANT'S ACCEPTANCE STATUS.

- ◆ Submit completed St. Francis High School Application for Admission. The \$75.00 application fee is applied towards application processing, compilation of documentation, interview scheduling, interview, admission committee review and/or written and/or telephonic communication(s) with the applicant, and current and/or previous school(s).
- ◆ Submit a current photograph of the applicant. (Optional)
- ◆ Insure that documents requested by St. Francis High School are received in a timely manner. These include: transcripts, standardized test scores, and recommendation(s).
- ◆ Letters of recommendation are not mandatory, but may be submitted (3 maximum). (**We do not provide forms.**)
- ◆ FAXED documents will not be accepted.
- ◆ You **must** complete the Transcript Release Authorization regardless of what type of school you attend (public, parochial, private, etc.). **If applicant attended more than one school in the past 3 years, please duplicate and complete a separate form for each school.**
- ◆ A personal interview of the prospective student and his parents/guardians by an Administrator is REQUIRED. You will be contacted regarding available dates and times after our freshman application process has been completed.
- ◆ All students seeking admission must not have any failing grades outstanding on their transcripts, i.e., failures must be made up before admission to St. Francis High School.

NOTE: TRANSFER STUDENTS: THE CIF OPEN ENROLLMENT POLICY STATES THAT ONLY STUDENTS WHOSE APPLICATIONS ARE RECEIVED PRIOR TO MAY 15 WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR UNRESTRICTED ELIGIBILITY.
